RACE EVENT: Sunday, 28 January 2018 Individual Sprint Race – Free Technique (9:00 start)

LOCATION: STAKE LAKE NORDIC CENTRE: 25 minutes south of Kamloops on the

Lac Le Jeune Rd. Start and Finish are located in the stadium, which is approximately 800 m from the day lodge and parking area. A concession and

warming area will be located adjacent to the stadium.

payment is required. THERE IS NO ADDITIONAL FEE FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION. RACE ENTRY Entry deadline is: Wednesday 24 January, 2018 AT 23:59 PST (1 minute to

MIDNIGHT) NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.

ELIGIBILITY: This race is designed to appeal to racers of all levels. If an individual wishes to race and they

are not a current member of a CCC/CCBC club, they must sign an Informed Consent and

Assumption of Risk Agreement.

LICENCES: No Licences are required

REFUNDS: Refunds will only be issued for those competitors who withdraw from the race prior to the

race entry deadline of 24 January 2018 at 23:59 PST. In the event of a cancellation due to bad weather conditions, the organizers reserve the right to recover costs incurred. Refunds for medical reasons are available upon receipt of a medical note

from a physician or nurse practitioner.

RACE FORMAT: The Sprint race will offer a qualification round (with 15 second interval starts) for all age categories.

The qualification round will be followed by the quarter-final and subsequent heats as soon as the organizers can prepare for them. Heats will be offered for age categories, not YOB. Small categories may be combined. All skiers will be given the opportunity to compete in a minimum of the

qualification round and one heat.

START LISTS: The start list will be posted at the Overlander Day Lodge and at the stadium It will

also be available on-line at www.zone4.ca following the draw at approximately 10 pm

(PST) on Thursday 23 January 2014.

RACE OFFICE: The event race office will be in the machine shed/warming building near the

stadium. It will be open Sunday from 7:30 am.

BIB PICK-UP: Bibs will be distributed from the Race Office beginning at 7:30AM. BIBS MUST BE PICKED UP

BY 8:30 am on SUNDAY (Day of Race). Clubs are encouraged to designate a coach or

other individual to pick up bibs for all skiers in their club.

AWARDS: Awards for ages 15 and under are sponsored by Teck. All Atoms who finish will receive a

special Teck participant ribbon. Awards for ages 16 and over will be provided by the

Overlander Ski Club. An Awards ceremony will occur directly after the race.

CONCESSION: There will be a concession available near the stadium serving a menu including chili and a

bun, hot dogs, cookies and various drinks. Please have cash for payment.

FACILITIES: A heated day lodge and washrooms are located near the parking area at the start of the

Stake Lake trail system, which is approximately 800 m from the Race Office and Stadium. The machine shop at the stadium area will be cleared and used as a warming room/lodge for the weekend. Portable toilets are available near the stadium and outhouses are located at

various locations along the trails.

PARKING A large parking lot is available near the Day Lodge. Parking in the small lot near the stadium is

limited and will be controlled by passes; one pass per club will be issued to a coach (coaches

please register on Zone4 to facilitate issuing of passes and other communication).

TRAIL FEES: Trail fees will be waived for all competitors, coaches and assistant coaches on race day

(Sunday) and on the official training day, Saturday 27 January 2018.

WAX FACILITIES:

Electrical outlets are available adjacent to the stadium. A few outlets are also available outside the Stake Lake day lodge (800 m from the stadium). No waxing is allowed inside the day lodge. Teams are encouraged to bring their own tent for waxing. Participants/Teams are responsible for cleaning up their waxing area. Please be reminded that at Regional Cup races the CCBC low-fluoro protocol applies to ALL age categories. This protocol includes the following"

- Structure tools ARE permitted.
- Non-Fluoro (NF) or Low Fluoro (LF) glide waxes ARE permitted.
- Medium Fluoro (MF) or High Fluoro (HF) glide waxes are NOT permitted.
- Pure Fluoro glide waxes (powders, pucks, blocks and liquids) are NOT permitted.
- Cold weather powder additives and hardeners are NOT permitted.

WAX TESTING: NO WAX TESTING ALLOWED on the course. A wax testing area will be designated.
